The table above presents terminal usage figures for the 3-month period: June 1978 through August 1978. The figures show usage in connect-minutes by keyboard number and by project number.

Project numbers 1-2 are Computer Center accounts

30 contains Admissions accounts

50 contains Faculty accounts

75 is for special accounts

The remaining project numbers indicate the graduation year of the students with those account numbers. Totals are stated in connect minutes.

Actual connect hours for the year September 1977 through August 1978 were 8777. Based on the budget above, cost per connect hour was \$2.82. This is an increase of \$.01 per connect hour when compared to the cost/connect hour for the previous year.

(It should be noted that the method for preparing the financial report has been changed. The report now includes a figure for depreciation of equipment but no longer includes the purchase price of major equipment nor does it include an overhead cost.)
